- Answers must be complete and correct, spelling counts!
- Each bonus you wish to claim must be listed on the scoresheet in the order they were completed.
- When you are ready to be scored, you must present this bonus listing (including all sheets), your completed scoresheet and any required receipts and photos (on your digital camera or smartphone). Once you sit down with the scorer you will not be allowed to leave the scoring table to retrieve anything you forgot.
- All photo bonuses must include your rally mug. If you break your mug then your face must appear in the photo. For two-up teams, one team member must appear in all photos along with the rally mug.
- Every effort has been made to ensure that each location has the correct directions and instructions to secure the points. Some locations have GPS coordinates to aid in locating the bonus. Others do not. Use of a Minnesota State highway map will also be useful.
- The rally begins at 9:00 am and ends at 5:00 pm. You have 8 hours to collect as many bonus points as you can. Riders arriving after 4:59:59 pm will be considered DNF (did not finish) and will not be scored.
- If you have any questions please see one of the rallymasters before you set out on your ride.
- If you are not going to finish the rally you MUST call the rallymaster to notify that you will not be returning. Please keep us from fretting about you.
