001 LCB Last Covered Bridge in MN - Zumbrota, MN Points: 68

44° 17.730′ -92° 40.227′

The last covered bridge in Minnesota located in Zumbrota MN. From hwy MN-58 in downtown Zumbrota for west on 2nd Street 1 block to West Ave turn right to go north to covered bridge. Get a photo of the bronze plaque "The Old Covered Bridge" in front of the bridge.

002 STC Stone Chair - Mazeppa, MN Points: 70

44° 16.385' -92° 32.934'

This stone chair was used by Eunice Philley Almeter Who was the Great Granddaughter of Joseph Ford jr. the founder of Mazeppa. From hwy MN-60 in Mazeppa turn north on First Ave S. In 2 blocks turn west on Walnut Street. Walk across the pedestrian bridge to the Stone Chair on the right. Get a photo of the Stone Chair.

003 RJD Richard J Dorer grave - Beaver, MN Points: 77

44° 09.156' -92° 01.192'

Richard Dorer was a former Minnesota Commissioner of Conservation. The Richard J Dorer State Forest with a million and a half acres here inn the driftless area is named in his honor. A half mile west of MN-74 on Co Rd 30 is a sign for the Beaver Cemetery. Follow the track up the hill to the small cemetery. On the left about half way back is a wooden marker with the outline of the state of Minnesota in metal this is the grave site of Richard J Dorer. Get a of Mr. Dorer's grave marker.

004 EFT Elba Fire Tower - Elba, MN

44° 05.477' -92° 00.633'

The Historic Elba Fire Tower The view from the top is breath taking but so is the climb to the tower, 634 steps. But I won't make you climb all the way to the tower, I'm not THAT kind of rallymaster. From Elba and hwy MN-74 go .02 of a mile east to a small parking lot. Climb up to the 52nd step and tell me the name on it. I don't need the dates.

This is a church the Laura Ingalls Wilder and her family attended. In Spring Valley follow South US-63 to Jefferson St. go west to Washington Ave then south to Courtland St. then west to the church. Get a photo of the "Methodist Church Museum Wilder Site" sign.

006 FCM Fillmore County Museum - Fountain, MN Points: 95

43° 44.333' -92° 08.270' 10:00am to 3:00pm

This is a great county museum lots an lots to see from the Pietenpol airplane to the two headed calf. The museum is open from 10 am to 3 pm. From US-52 follow Co Rd 8 east into Fountain. The museum is on the south side of the road 0.1 miles from US-52. Get a photo of the two headed calf, you may need to ask the staff for directions.

007 IPW Inspiration Point Wayside - Lanesboro, MN Points: 84

43° 41.628' -91° 59.879'

Inspiration Point Wayside is on the eastern end entertaining part of hwy MN-16. The wayside is 2 miles east of hwy US52. Inside the wayside is a Minnesota historical marker "Minnesota's Norwegian Americans". Get a photo of this historical marker.

008 EGS Ernie's Gas Station - Whalan, MN Points: 78

43° 43.878' -91° 55.494'

Ernie is quite the collector and has a great little throw back to an old time filling station. To the left of Ernie's is a sign "High Water". What is the date of the high water on this sign?

009 ROL Rushford Overlook - Rushford, MN

43° 48.659' -91° 45.541' 6:00am to 10:30pm

The Rushford overlook give you a great view of the Root River valley and how it's carved out of the landscape. From Rushford Mill Street aka MN43 go west on Jessie Street aka MN30 for 3/4 of a mile. Turn right on Magelsson Dr. keep left at the fork to the overlook. At the overlook is a plaque "Rushford Area Map" on the map what number is Norsland Lefse?

010 HTT Houston Tank - Houston, MN

43°45'43.1"N 91°34'14.2"W

In the north east corner of the Houston City Park is a veterans memorial. Part of the memorial is a tank, an M3A Stuart to be exact. From MN16 in Houston go south on Lincoln Street one block to the park. There's a brass plaque on the front of the tank. According to that plaque what is the MPG of the tank?

011 KSH Karst Sinkhole - Harmony, MN

43° 33.509' -92° 00.885'

Members of the Harmony Area Historical Society purchased a sinkhole, located near the Harmony-Preston Bike Trail. The group hopes to use the sinkhole as an educational tool for both local residents and visitors to the area. The sinkhole is a good example of the unique geological make-up of southeastern Minnesota. From US52 in Harmony go west on Fourth Street 0.2 of a mile to the Root River Trail, unmarked. It's a paved trail heading north. Follow the trail to the Karst Sinkhole, about an 8 minute walk. Get a photo of the info Plaque "Sunken Treasure".

012 ACS The American Capital of Steam Engines - Mable, MN Points: 99

43° 31.455′ -91° 46.146′

Mable MN is the self proclaimed American Capital of Steam Engines. I mean who could dispute that? On sort of a frontage road off of hwy MN44 and Elm Street in Mable is a steam engine tractor. On that tractor is a brass plaque. Who donated that memorial?

According to the sign how far is it from Spring Valley MN to Walnut Grove MN?

015 HLS Historic Locust School - Decorah, IA

43° 25.304′ -91° 43.311′

The historic Locust School is located about 8 miles northeast of Decorah at the intersection of Locust Rd aka Co Rd W38 and Big Canoe Rd aka 337th St. By the school is a Winneshiek County Historical Society marker. Get a photo of this historical marker.

016 GLC Glenwood Luthern Church - Decorah, IA

43° 17.020' -91° 38.024'

The Glenwood Church is about 7 miles east of Decorah. From hwy US52 go east on WI9 2.5 miles. Turn left on Old Stage Rd, go 7 miles to the church. By the church is a stone sign with time for the worship services. On that sign is a brass plaque. The plaque is in memory of who?

017 VFH Village Farm and Home - Waukon, IA

43° 14.968' -91° 28.416'

A muffler man statue this time a cowboy and a bull. 1.8 miles south of Main Street and hwy WI-76/9 on the east side of the road. Get a photo of the Cowboy and the Bull.

018 MPE Marquette's Pink Elephant - Marquette, IA

43° 02.463' -91° 10.675'

Pinky the elephant out in from of the Casino Queen casino. From hwy US18 in Marquette go south on Business US18 0.1 of a mile to the Pink elephant. Next to Pinky is a sign chronicling his life. What month and year did Pinky waterski on the Mississippi river to greet President Jimmy Carter?

At the very heart of the Driftless area a small berg with a nice veterans memorial. 17 miles northeast of Prairie du Chine one way to get there is WI-60 just east of Wauzeka (no I didn't make that up) take WI-131 north to Stueben. Get a photo of the veterans memorial

021 MHV Mt Hosmer - Lansing, IA

43° 21.987' -91° 13.278' Daylight Only

Mt Hosmer so named for Harriet Hosmer a famous sculptress who won a foot race to the summit during a steamboat layover in 1851. But we're here for the view. From hwy IA9 in Lansing go north on 6th street to the entrance for the Mt Hosmer Park. Be careful the first turn into the park is a steep and sharp corner, after that it's a breeze. Follow the road to the restrooms at the top. walk out to the overlook and find the info plaque "The Upper Mississippi River Nation Wildlife and Fish Refuge" it show different sights from the view. What number is Goose Carcass Lake?

022 CVM Culvert Man - Nodine, MN

43° 54.300' -91° 25.705'

From I-90 Exit 267 go south on Co Rd 12, left at T to follow Co Rd 12. Go 0.2 to Nodine Culvert Sales and the man made of culverts. Get a photo of the Culvert Man.

025 VMS Vasa Mattson's Settlement - Vasa, MN

44° 30.223′ -92° 43.428′

Vasa was once called he most Swedish colony in America. From Welch follow Co Rd 7 south 5.7 miles follow Co Rd 7 west at Norelius Rd. Look for the historical marker on the right. Get a photo of the "Vasa: Mattison's Settlement" marker.

026 RMP Redwing Memorial Park - Redwing, MN

44° 33.770′ -92° 31.426′ 8:00am to 10:30PM

Redwing Memorial Park has great overlook of the city of Redwing. Follow how US-61/63 southeast out of Redwing. Turn right at MN-292 but don't follow MN-292 make a 180* turn and follow E seventh St. for 0.6 of a mile turn left onto Skyline Dr. follow that to the overlook with a flag pole. At the overlook there is a large inlaid compass (not a real compass), a multi point star with N, S, W, E. Get a photo of the compass.

027 FBH Fort Beacharnois - Frontenac, MN

44° 30.416′ -92° 19.463′

Here's a bonus that could have been in the 2024 NSR New Deal. The historical marker was constructed in 1940 by the National Youth Administration. Fort Beauharnios French fort, serving as a fur trading post and Catholic Mission. It was one of the last French forts along the Mississippi. The marker is 1.5 miles SE of the Whistle Stop in Frontenac. Get a photo of the marker.

029 WPS Wapahasha - Wabasha, MN

44° 23.048' -92° 01.858'

Wapshssha was to the Eastern Dakota Indians what George Washington was to Americans. From hwy US-61 near Wabasha got east on MN-60. Go straight where MN-60 turns left and follow that to the Mississippi river. There you will find a memorial to Wapshssha. Get a photo of the statue of Wapshssha.

030 LTM Lark Toy Museum - Kellog, MN

44° 18.024' -92° 00.289'

The Lark Toy Museum great place for the kids of any age. A old time carousel, candies, Mini Golf and of course toys. From US-61 just outside of Kellog go west on Co Rd 18. Take an immediate left on 170th Street. Follow that to the museum. Not far from the front door is a VW beetle cut out. Get a photo of the beetle, better yet get one with you behind the wheel.

031 STG Stephen Taylor Grave - Winona, MN

44° 02.215' -91° 39.434'

From hwy US-61 in Winona go west on Co Rd 44, immediately turn right on Lake Blvd. go 0.2 of a mile to the Woodlawn Cemetery entrance. Keep left at the first fork then take the first right. The grave is on you right surrounded by a fort like structure. On the Fort like structure there is a brass plaque "In Memory of". Who erected this plaque in 1933? Notice the flag flying above the Stephen Taylor grave site.

032 OSO Old Settlers Overlook - Stoddard, WI

43° 36.855' -91° 13.205'

From hwy WI-162 go 3.4 miles south turn to go east on Spring Coulee Rd. Go 0.1 of a mile to unmarked road to Scenic Overlook. Follow that just past the overlook to Wing Dam Park. According to the sign "Wing Dam Park" what do wing dams do?

033 BAC Bad Axe Church - Viroqua, WI

43° 31.334′ -91° 02.666′

Bad Axe Church is located 8 miles Southwest of Viroqua. Got west from Viroqua on WI-56 for 7.7 miles, turn south on Co Rd N in 2 miles you will come to the church. There's a small red sign by the steps up to the church "Town of Sterling". What are the numbers and letters on that sign?

034 FGW The Forgotten Works - Viroqua, WI

43° 33.497' -90° 52.982'

The Forgotten Works is an eclectic collection of mostly books but lots of other old stuff. On the third Saturday in July they hold the Lorem Ipsum Motorcycle Picnic which draws lots of Euro and vintage motorcycles. The Forgotten Works are located in a historical section of Viroqua. From the intersection of US-14 and WI-56 go east 4 blocks then north on East Ave, turn right on Walnut Street. Look for the brown brick building that says "Viroqua Leaf Tobacco". Above the door on the south side of the building it says "This is the entrance to the Forgotten Works Be Careful". Why should you be careful?

035 CFF 1 Crazy Franks Flea Market - Mineral Point, WI Points: 162

42° 52.546' -90° 10.124'

Crazy Frank's Flea Market, so much junk you didn't know you needed. From WI-39 aka Fountain St and Bus US-151 aka Ridge St go north out of Mineral Point 1.4 miles. Crazy Frank's will be on your left. Get a photo of the big "Crazy Frank's Flea Market" sign by the road.

035 CFF 2 Crazy Franks Flea Market - Reads Town, WI Points: 162

43° 26.549' -90° 46.042'

Crazy Frank's second location. Go south from US14 and US-61 0.1 miles Crazy Frank's is on your right. Get a photo of the big "Crazy Frank's Flea Market" sign by the road.

036 OCM Ocooch Mountains - Boaz, WI Points: 119

43° 20.052′ -90° 31.580′

This marker talks about the Black Hawk war of 1832. Go about 7 miles west of Richland Center on US-14 then turn south on WI-171. Go 1/2 mile turn right into the parking lot for the Boaz Community Building. Look for the Wisconsin Historical Marker "Ocooch Mountains". Get a photo of this historical marker.

037 SLD Starlite14 Drive In - Richland Center, WI Points: 131

43° 18.938' -90° 21.036'

One of the few remaining drive in movie theater. The Starlite14 is on the northeast corner of US-14 and Co Rd O in Richland Center. Get a photo of the "Starlite 14" sign.

038 UNC Unity Chapel - Spring Green, WI Points: 141

43° 07.966' -90° 03.682'

Built in 1886 by, and for, the descendants of Richard and Mary Lloyd-Jones and also contains the grave of Frank Lloyd Wright. Just outside the gates leading into the chapel in the ground is a brass plaque "United Chapel Dedicated 1886". Get a phot of this plaque.

039 HOR House on the Rock - Spring Green, WI

43° 05.654' -90° 07.882'

11:00am - 5:00pm

But the real attraction is the Boeing C-97 that landed here for filming of a commercial with Farah Fawcett. The Don Q is 1.5 miles north of US-18 in Dodgeville on WI-23. Get a photo of the Boeing C-97.

041 CVC Carr Valley Cheese - Fennimoore, WI

42° 58.631′ -90° 39.323′

Plenty of cheese shops all across Wisconsin. But Carr Valley has Igor, a giant mouse with a piece of cheese. You'll find Igor 0.8 of a mile south of US-18 on US-61. Get a photo of Igor. One thing, Igor is on wheels and could be off at a parade somewhere in that case get a photo of the "Carr Valley Cheese" sign out front.

042 CVF Cassville Ferry - Cassville, WI

42° 42.817' -90° 59.544'

The Cassville Ferry was used to transport vegetables from the rich bottom land soil of Iowa. From WI-133 in Cassville turn southwest on Wall Street, cross the railroad tracks and go right, follow that to the end by the ferry terminus. Follow the side walk farther to a gazebo like structure, a scenic overlook of the river. One of the info plaques in the gazebo is "Cassville - A River Town". According to the info plaque Ferry service was powered by ______ on a treadmill started in 1836.

043 GOP Good Old Potosi Beer - Potosi, WI

42° 40.569' -90° 43.465'

Founded in 1852, the Potosi® Brewing Company became the fifth largest brewery in Wisconsin and distributed coast to coast. The brewery survived prohibition but closed in 1972. Following a \$7.5 million restoration, the Potosi Brewery Foundation, a non-profit organization and sole owner of the Potosi Brewing Company, reopened the brewery in 2008. The facility is home to theTM, a brewpub, restaurant, beer garden, gift shop, and Great River Road Interpretive Center. The Potosi Brewery's mission is to channel profits into its markets served to support historical and educational based initiatives, and charitable causes. From WI-133 turn southeast on Brewery Hollow Road, go 100 yards and burn right into the parking lot of the Holiday Garden Event Center. Look for the very large Potosi bottle/can. Get a photo of the bottle/can.

Also known as the Fourth Street Elevator, this funicular railway has been called "the world's steepest, shortest scenic railway." 296 feet in length, elevating passengers 189 feed from Fourth Street up to Fenelon Place. Magnificent view of downtown Dubuque business district, the Mississippi River and three states. From US-61 in Dubuque take exit 189B, at the bottom of the ramp go west. Coming from the north that will be 11th street, coming from the south that will be 9th street. Follow that to Bluff street, go south to 4th street, go west to the elevator. Get a photo of the lower terminus of the elevator.

046 GCS Gile Cheese Shop - Cuba City

42° 36.418' -90° 25.843'

Like I said there are plenty of cheese shops all across Wisconsin. Located on WI-80 in Cuba City between Clay and Benton streets on the east side of the street. According to the big sign by the street "Gile Cheese". When were they established?

047 MAC Masonic Cemetery - New Diggings, WI

42° 32.285′ -90° 20.578′

The Masonic Cemetery is about 2 miles southeast of Benton, WI. The cemetery is on Co Rd W just west of downtown New Diggings. Get a photo of the entrance archway.

050 - NGB New Glarus Brewery - New Glarus

42° 47.727′ -89° 37.773′ **10:00am - 5:00pm**

New Glarus Brewing Company wasted no time establishing itself as a world class operation. In 1992, Daniel Carey passed the Diploma Master Brewer's Exam at the Institute of Brewing, London. The first barrels rolled out in November of 1993 - the fastest micro brewery start-up ever. The new brewery is 1.2 miles south of WI-39 in New Glarus on WI-69. Turn east on Cow Path Lane, follow that to the parking lot, turn right and at the far end of the parking lot there is an all white cow. In spite of the fact that New Glarus flagship brew is Spotted Cow this cow has no spots. Get photo of this spotless cow.

051 BVW Blanchardville Mural - Blanchardville, WI

42° 48.543′ -89° 51.762′

Right in the heart of Blanchardville is the Junk and Disorderly Antique shop. On the south side of the antique shop is a mural a tribute to Balcchardville. Blanchardville is 10.5 miles was of New Glarus, WI on WI-78. Get a photo of the mural.

054 SSC S&S Cycle - Viola, WI

43° 29.685' -90° 38.017'

S&S Cycle is the go to high performance engine builder for all things Harley Davidson. From Viola go east on WI-56 1.7 miles and turn south on Co Rd G, about 0.4 of a mile on the east side of the road is the entrance to S&S Ranch. Get a photo of the archway over the entrance.

055 WCS Westby Cheese and Gift Store - Westby, WI

43° 39.166' -90° 51.470'

Hey! Another cheese store! Well it is Wisconsin. According to the sign on the front of the store. Westby cheese has been around since when?

056 BSP Bangor Stockyard Park - Bangor, WI

057 MDC Mindoro Cut - West Salem, WI

43° 58.458' -91° 05.722'

The Mindoro cut is 74 feet deep, 86 feet long, and 25 feet wide. It is the second-deepest cut built by hand in the Western Hemisphere and the oldest functional cut which has not been improved upon. From West Salem head north on WI-108 veer off to the left onto CoRd C. Follow Co Rd C 4.3 miles to the cut. On the west side of the road there is a historical marker and a bench.
